**REGULATOR APPROVED CHANGE IN TARIFF PER UNIT OF ELECTRICITY. THIS ORDER OF THE REGULATOR REVOKES ORDER NO 2017/E54.**

The following tariff charges shall become effective commencing **01 FEBRUARY 2018**
