The following tariff charges shall become effective commencing **01 SEPTEMBER 2017**

INDUCTION METER USERS

The 2% discount is removed from Induction Meter Users for advance payment of bills.

PREPAYMENT METER USERS (CASHPOWER)

The 2% discount is removed from Prepayment Meter Users.
